HEALTH SERVICES INFORMATION

New York State Education Law requires that all students present a physician signed certificate of immunization before entering school. This certificate should be presented at the time of registration and must include the month, day, and year that your child received their immunizations. The required immunizations are:

- 3 doses of **diphtheria toxoid**
- 3 doses of **oral polio vaccine** (OPV or TOPV)
OR 3 doses of enhanced inactivated poliovirus (eIPV)
OR 4 doses of IPV
OR a combination of 4 doses of OPV and eIPV
- 2 doses of **Measles** vaccine, the first administered after 12 months of age and the second after 15 months of age. (Children born on or after 1/1/85- all other children need only one dose.)
- 1 dose of **Mumps** vaccine administered after 12 months of age.
- 1 dose of **Rubella** vaccine administered after 12 months of age.
- 3 doses of **Hepatitis B** vaccine for students born on or after 1/1/93.
- 3 doses of **Hepatitis B** vaccine for students entering 7th grade on or after September, 2000.
- 1 dose of **Varicella** vaccine for students born on or after 1/1/98 and entering Kindergarten in September 2003 **OR** physician certified proof of disease.

All new students to the district, and all students in grades K, 1, 3, and 7 must have a physical examination. Ideally, this exam should be conducted by your private physician, but if this is not possible, the physical will be provided at the district's expense by the school physician. The physical must be given on or after January 1 of the current school year. You will be given a physical form which your physician should complete at the time of the examination and return to school before the first day of school. If the form is not returned, a physical will be given by the district physician at the district's expense.

Some other health-related services your child will receive are:

1. Convex lens test- 1st grade
2. Vision screening- yearly
3. Hearing screening- yearly in grades K-7, and 10th grade
4. Color perception- 4th grade
5. Height and weight- yearly
6. Scoliosis screening- yearly between the ages of 8 and 16

If any irregularities are found in any of these areas, you will be notified.
